WORK UNDER RUSA



Double storied building of Girls' common room constructed under the aegis of RUSA

RASHTRIYA UCHATTAR SHIKSHA ABHIYAAN (RUSA)

Rashtriya Uchattar Shiksha Abhiyaan (RUSA) is a centrally sponsored scheme launched in 2013 under the flagship of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India for the growth of higher education in the country. The scheme aims at providing strategic funding to higher education institutions throughout the country. It is a matter of pride for our college to get a sanction of ₹ 2 crore infrastructure grant under RUSA 2.0 in 2019. As per RUSA guidelines, the institute utilised this amount under the following heads: - New Construction, Renovation /Upgradation and New equipment. The entire project of RUSA is being monitored by Special Project Director, RUSA in Haryana. The college has formed a Project Monitoring Unit (PMU) to ensure judicious utilisation of funds and smooth working of the project. Under the leadership of the Principal, coordinated by Nodal Officer Dr. Vinay Khurania, and team members Dr. Minu Singal, Mr Sanjeev Sharma, Mr Inder Singh and Mr. Abhimanyu, PMU has been consistently contributing in this direction. The major work done under RUSA is mentioned below:

1. A spacious canteen and five classrooms were constructed. The canteen has a large kitchen, a store room, a washing room and a big well-furnished dining hall. Separate washrooms for the canteen have also been constructed.
2. With the increasing strength of students, there was a long awaited demand for Girls' common room. A double-storey building with separate washrooms was constructed in 2024 for the purpose.
3. The college established in 1984, required major renovation and upgradation. Haryana Police Housing Corporation was handed over this project. Major repairs were done -rain pipes at various points were replaced to stop seepage, flooring in three classrooms was changed from cement to granite, ceilings & roof tops at many places were repaired, and internal corridor walls in the old academic block were tiled.
4. College gate was renovated using granite.
5. Cabins were created in the non-teaching room by using glass and aluminium partitions.
6. ACs and water coolers were installed at various points. New desktops, photocopier machines, scanner were purchased for smooth functioning of administrative services.
7. Audio podiums were installed in the classrooms having a bigger strength.
8. Mr. Tejveer Singh, President, Governing Body of the college inaugurated video conferencing room on 20th Sep 2023 and expressed his word of appreciation for the efforts put in by the RUSA team.
9. A highly required energy-efficient dream was fulfilled by launching 50 KWs solar panel in February 2025.
10. To facilitate sports students, sports items e.g. tread mill, racing cycles were purchased.
11. Two book shelves and some books were purchased for the library.

RUSA team extends a deep sense of gratitude to our governing body under whose vision and unwavering support this work was executed. 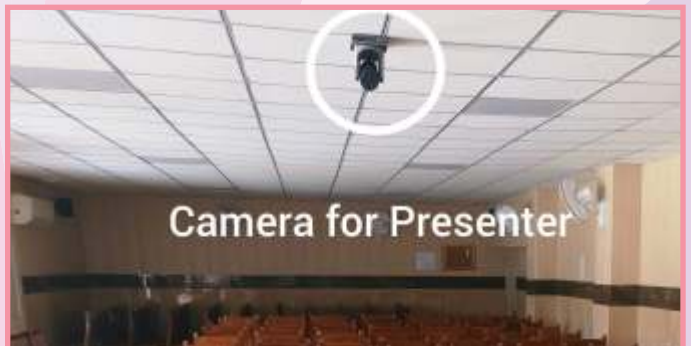

INTERNSHIP CELL

The Internship Cell was formed in the year 2024 - 25 with the objective of creating awareness on internship amongst the students and to create opportunities for them by bringing institutions or companies from local and nearby places to the college so that they could select students for internship and placement. As per curriculum designed under NEP 2020, it was mandatory for each and every 2nd year student of UG classes and 1st year student of PG classes to do internship from some organisation and this internship is considered as a paper carrying 4 credits. Under the able guidance of the Principal Dr. Amita, Internship Coordinator Dr. Minu Singal, Internship In-charges Mrs Sushila Garg, Dr. Vinay Khurania, Mr Vinesh Walia and Miss Monica and almost the entire staff as teacher supervisors worked throughout the year in this direction. The Internship Cell arranged for the internship of 360 undergraduate and 110 postgraduate students in the year 2024-25. The students did their internship from a wide variety of institutions. Some learned skills such as tailoring, make-up, computer applications; some of the students did their internship online such as from Swayam portal; some joined gram panchayats, libraries, Dharohar Museum, income tax lawyers, chartered Accountants et.al.

In the academic year 2024-25, the college signed Memorandum of Understanding with three institutions - Pragati Pariwar Samiti, Kurukshehra; Hartron Skill Centre, Pundri, 127; and Anum Professional Academy, Pundri to provide internships to our UG and PG students at minimum fee or free of cost. Following activities were undertaken under the Internship Cell:-

1. A company Anum Cosmetics visited the college on 30th April, 2025 to interact with students and inform them about the kind of skills offered by them for internship. The visit was a success. More than 60 students of 2nd year joined the institution for internship after attending their presentation session.
2. The Internship Cell invited a company Pragati Pariwar Samiti on 4th April, 2025 in the college premises to select students of 2nd year for internship and students of final year for placement. This visit was also a success. 57 students from 2nd year of various streams were selected as interns and 8 final year students from different streams got a job offer from the company. Mr. Vishavdeep Sharma, SEBI Smart Trainer agreed to be their mentor.
3. A workshop of all the members of the internship cell including the teacher supervisors and the teacher in-charges of different streams was held in the video conferencing room by the internship coordinator Dr. Minu Singal on 29th March 2025. In the workshop all the members were apprised of the current progress regarding internship and the entire process of internship was explained in detail through power point presentation by the coordinator to all the members followed by discussion amongst the members regarding different aspects of internship.
4. Another workshop was organised on 18th February 2025. It was for the students of 2nd year of all the streams to create awareness about internship.
